Music Enrichment includes timetabled music lessons, instrumental lessons (for current IMSS students) and ensemble. Embedded in the Music Enrichment program are units providing engaging and creative learning experiences to equip our students with future skills. Our Study Hacks program which reinforces and educates students on personal learning and study techniques is delivered through this program.

There are **three options** for applying to enrol in the music enrichment program.

**OPTION ONE - Applying through IMSS**

Students who are currently studying music through the Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS) program. Instrumental tuition is offered on any instrument you **currently** study through the Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS).

**OPTION – TWO Applying as a non IMSS student**

The school will provide two periods of music lessons per week and there will be an opportunity to join ensembles.
