YEAR GROUP FB GROUPS

Each Year group will also have a Facebook Group. A new group is set up for each year group by the P&C Year Group Coordinator.

Periodic parent social get-togethers for each year group may be organised and shared through these groups. These events may coincide with student year group social functions, e.g. River Cruise or Dinner Dance. Parents arrange a meet up close by to the student event while students attend their social.

These events are a great way to connect with other parents in the year groups.

WE DON'T FUNDRAISE

We are funded through the P&C Voluntary Contribution on your child's annual College invoice. As prescribed in our constitution each funding request is discussed on its own merits and then voted on in our regular meetings.

Occasionally we will apply for a grant for funding a specific project at the College, for example the Bush Tucker Garden.




WHAT WE HAVE FUNDED

Industry professionals, college staff and students providing insights on the following topics:


